SIMNA is a nimble and growing organisation. We are an active Board, supportive of each other and of our collective desire to support SIMNA's growth.

Each Board member will be responsible for leading areas of operational development. This is not an honorary position, but a role where you have the opportunity to help shape the future of social impact measurement in Australia and our growing network.
