### **The Board role**

SIMNA is a nimble, young and growing organisation. We are an active Board, supportive of each other and of our collective desire to support SIMNA's growth.

Each Board member will be responsible for leading an area of operational development. This is not an honorary position, but a role where you have the opportunity to help shape the future of Social Impact Measurement in Australia and our growing network.

The Board encourages applicants from diverse backgrounds, including Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders, young people, people with lived experience of disability and people of colour.

The commitment will be for approximately one day of work per month. We actively use slack for all communications and have a Board meeting every 4 weeks, via videoconference, currently planned for last Thursday of the month between 3-5pm (AEDT), for two hours.
